

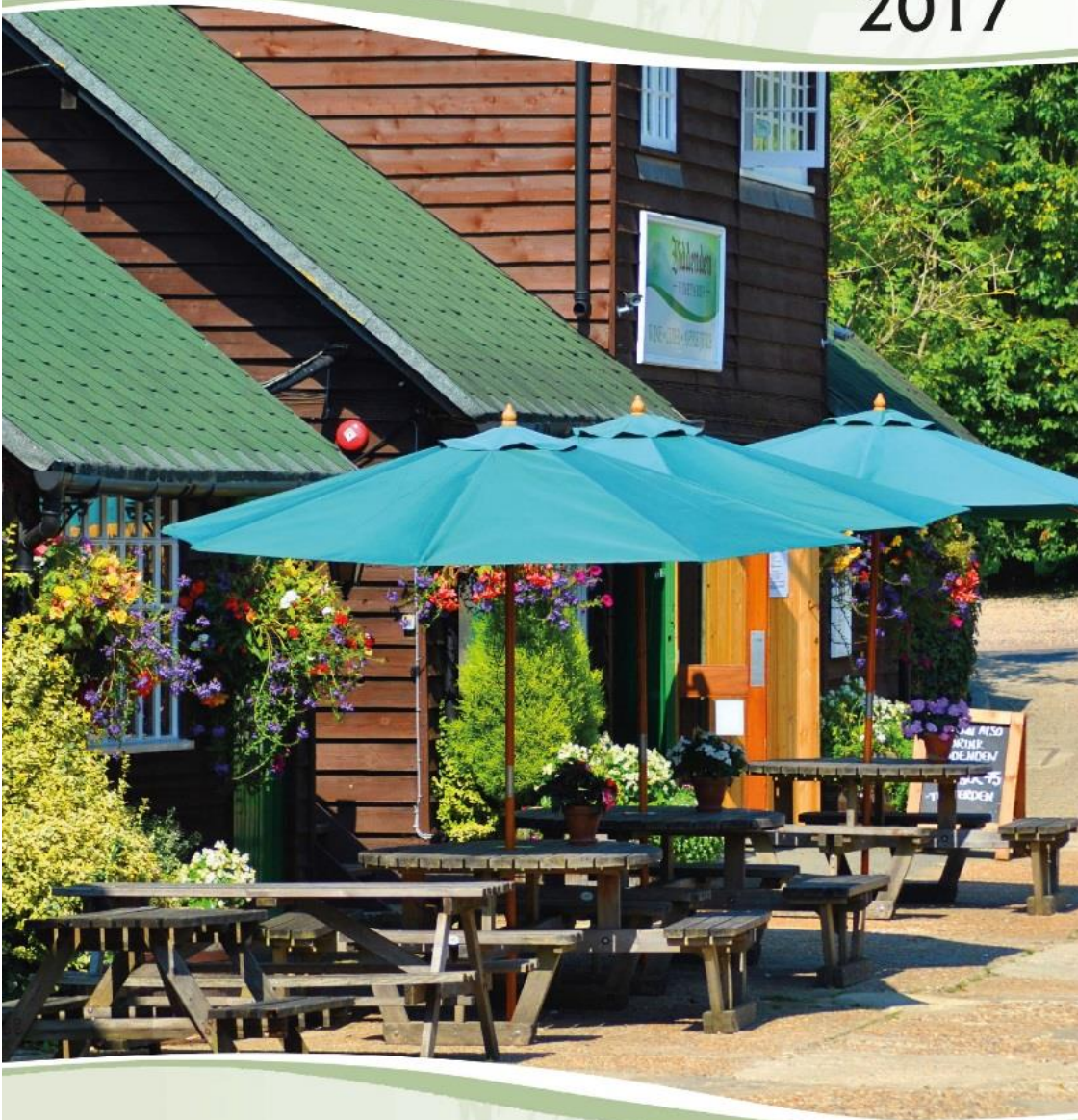

Biddenden Vineyard is Kent's oldest commercial vineyard, having been established by the Barnes family in 1969 to produce wines and ciders. The vineyards are set in 23 acres on a gentle south facing slope in a shallow sheltered valley, 1.2 miles from the lovely Wealden village of Biddenden. Eleven varieties of grapes are grown to produce White, Red, Rosé and Quality Sparkling wines. Traditional Kentish ciders have also been made here for over 40 years together with farm pressed apple and pear juices.

Visitors are welcome throughout the year. Our wines, ciders and juices are available to taste and the shop is stocked with a wide range of locally produced jams, chutneys, cheeses, beers and more.

GROUP GUIDED VINEYARD TOURS

Our group tours are by prior booking only and subject to a minimum of 15 and a maximum of 25 people per group. The price includes a glass of wine per adult or juice for children.

Tour prices: Adults – £10 Children - £8 (12-17 years) Under 12's - £3

Prices for smaller groups and private tours are available on request.

A wedge of freshly baked local bread, Cheddar cheese and home baked ham served with salad and a selection of pickles. A glass of wine, cider or apple juice is served with the meal – **£19.00 per person.**



EVENING SUPPER TOURS

Enjoy a glass of chilled cider on arrival, followed by a vineyard and winery tour.

Your Ploughman's platter is then served, accompanied with a glass of wine of your choice.

For your own comfort evening supper tours are limited to a maximum of 35 people (minimum 15).

KENTISH CHEESE & WINE *With Winterdale Cheesemakers*

Arrive at Biddenden Vineyards at 11.30am for a guided tour of the vineyard and winery followed by a Ploughman's platter served with Winterdale cheese, local ham and a glass of wine. At 1.30pm depart for Winterdale Cheesemakers, for a guided tour of the dairy & cave, followed by cheese tastings and a Kentish cream tea in a truly rural setting.

NARROW LINES & WINES *With Romney Hythe & Dymchurch Railway*

Arrive at Hythe Station for a ride on the train departing at 10.20am for New Romney. At New Romney there is plenty of time to visit the Railway Museum or have a cup of tea. From here to Biddenden your coach will take you through some delightful Kentish scenery. On arrival at Biddenden at 12.45pm you will be served a Ploughman's platter and a glass of wine. Then it's time for a guided tour of the vineyard and the chance to taste and buy some of the excellent wines and ciders produced at the vineyard.

NUTS ABOUT WINE *With Potash Farm*

Arrive at Biddenden Vineyards at 10.30am and enjoy a guided tour through the vineyard and winery followed by a Ploughman's platter served with a glass of wine. Depart at 1pm for Potash Farm for a village and farm walk, a splendid educational opportunity to learn the ins and outs of commercial cobnut production followed by tea or coffee and biscuits and a chance to browse the exclusive range of Kentish Cobnut, Walnut, Chestnut, Almond and Pecan nut products.

VINES, WINES & RAILWAY LINES *With Kent & East Sussex Railway*

Arrive at Biddenden Vineyards at 12 noon for a Ploughman's platter served with a glass of wine, followed by a guided tour of the vineyard and winery. At 2.40pm it's time to depart for Tenterden Station to join the train for a nostalgic trip back in time on a steam train from a bygone era whilst enjoying a Kentish cream tea.

LAVENDER AND WINE *With Castle Farm, Shoreham*

Arrive at Biddenden Vineyards at 11.30am and enjoy a guided tour through the vineyard and winery followed by a glass of sparkling wine served with your Ploughman's platter. Depart at 1.30pm for Castle Farm. Take in the fabulous views while you tour the Lavender fields and in the distillery learn the whole process of this truly English product. Enjoy an apple juice tasting and visit the shop with the opportunity to purchase all the Lavender products produced on the farm.

Available Monday – Friday from the last week of June for 5 weeks.

HOW TO BOOK

Contact the Vineyard to check availability of the date and time you would like to visit, as there are restricted dates.

A deposit of 50% is payable on booking to confirm your tour. Provisional bookings will only be reserved for 7 working days.

We require final numbers 7 working days prior to your visit. After this time the deposit becomes un-refundable.

Final payment can be made on or before the day of your visit.

For your own comfort, we are unable to take group bookings for over 25 people.
